

The NTFP Centre of Excellence invites Expression of Interest (EoI) from interested buyers of dry plucked (inflorescences) Broom Grass from Joint Forest Management Committees (JFMCs)/ Self-help Groups (SHGs)/ Village Development Planning & Implementation Committees (VDPICs), Joint Liability Groups (JLGs) etc under the following Forest Ranges with the Terms and Conditions as mentioned below, along with earnest money (EMD) to be deposited along with the Bids:

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Terms and Conditions:


1. Only pluck broom grass has to be collected. Initially the inflorescence has to be cut at the base and later on plucking has to be done. Direct plucking from the plant is completely banned.
2. The traders/bidders have to quote for both per kg green and per kg dry pluck grass **excluding royalty and other applicable taxes and RF depoist**
3. **The traders who did not adhere to the tender conditions in the last year tender are barred from participating in this year tender**
4. The Range officer has to open a separate CD account for receipt of advance money deposit from the successful bidder and also for disbursing it to the individual collectors. The successful bidder (Trader) for a particular range has to give money advance at regular intervals and amount matching to the potential of the ranges to the account (CD account) opened by Range officer and only after the advance is deposited in the RF account, the trader will be allowed to collect the grass. The trader who fails to deposit advance as per demand of collectors in the range, the trader will disqualified and next highest quoted bidder will notified for further collection. All codal formalities have to observed by RO for operating the CD account .
5. The disbursement to the bank accounts of the individual collector/harvester will be based on the quantity of grass collected and after the signed report from the trader and physical verification of stock by the Range officer or Forester concerned. **The trader has to give in writing to the concerned RO for disbursement of the money to the collectors.**
6. The amount of initial advance to be deposited by successful bidder is as per the **Annexure A**
7. Sub contract is not allowed.
8. Qualified Bidders will be short-listed for each Range. The Bidder who has quoted highest (total of dry and green rate quoted will be considered)

- and in case of tie, rate quoted for green per kg will be considered for declaring successful bidder.
9. The Bidder who has quoted highest price will be declared successful for the Range and will be allowed to collect the dry pluck broom at the price quoted.
 10. No person other than the successful Bidder or his authorized representative shall be allowed to procure the fuljharu from the concerned Range. Forest Department staff will issue Transit Pass for fuljharu only to the authorized representative of the successful Bidder, on realization of royalties, RF contribution and other dues of the Government. The successful Bidders shall procure Broom grass from JFMCs/ SHGs/ VDPICs/JLGS ETC. Fuljharu collected from non-JFM areas will be channelized through nearest JFMC.
 11. Each trader has to submit weekly report to the Director (NCE weekly report countersigned by the Range Officer, indicating the quantity of fuljharu collected by him during the week.
 12. In case, the successful Bidder fails to procure the fuljharu at the price quoted after making the complete payment, the offer will automatically stand cancelled from the date of default and next highest Bidder will be declared as "Successful Bidder" for the Range without further correspondence.
 13. Each successful Bidder will declare location of his Collection Centres and local Beat Officer and Range Officer will be informed about it by the successful Bidder before starting collection. The local Range Officer will monitor the activities of the Collection Centre.
 14. The Bidders should have valid licence to carry in trade in forest produce (FTL).
 15. ***The Base Price for the Green plucked broom grass is Rs 19 per kg (Rupees nineteen only) and for dry plucked broom grass is Rs 58 per kg (Rupees fifty eight only).***
 16. Prospective Bidders should quote over and above the Base Price.
 17. Interested Buyers will deposit their price offers for each Range along with their business profile along with a Demand draft/ D-Call for the EMD (**As**

per the details in annexure B) only drawn in favour of “**Director, NTFP Centre of Excellence, Gandhigram, Agartala**” payable at Agartala in a sealed envelope superscribed “**EoI for Broom Grass 2016-17**” either in person or by post/ courier so as to reach this office not later than **5 PM on 09th January, 2017** at the address given above. Any EoI received after the stipulated time will summarily be rejected. In case of failure on the part of the trader to continue business the EMD shall be forfeited to NCE. EMD of unsuccessful Bidders will be returned/ released **within 45 days of closure of the EoI**. The EMD of the successful bidders will be released 15th March, 2017.

18. The bidders have to provide information about name, phone nos, Adhar card of the bidder as well as of their authorised representative in tender document itself. Successful bidder and also their authorised representatives/agents will have to produce the document (ID, Adhar, PAN) physically at NCE.
19. Each trader can bid for maximum of 2 Ranges in the tender process.
20. The authority has discretion in allotting ranges wherever there is no participation from the bidder in order to ensure the proper collection.
21. The successful bidder has to **deposit 5 % of value** of the grass collected from each JFMC to the Revolving fund.
22. The successful bidder will also have to deposit **2 %** of the value of the collection to the Biodiversity Management Committee (BMC) Account (by account payee cheque) where BMCs are in existence and in areas where BMCs have not been formed so far, this amount has to be deposited in the Tripura Biodiversity Board account (by account payee cheque)
23. In addition, the successful bidder will also have to deposit **1 %** of the value of the collection in the Tripura Biodiversity Board (TBB) account
24. The bidders/traders who fail to adhere to the terms and conditions or involve in disruptive trade practise will be black listed and also the FTL will be cancelled.
25. **The NTFP Centre of Excellence reserves the right to accept or reject offer either partially or fully or intervene at any state for smooth collection of the broom grass.**

26. The above mentioned 3% (as mentioned under SNo.21, 22 & 23) is in addition to the normal royalty and other taxes which are in vogue in the forest department
27. Other information may be known from the office of the undersigned.
28. Detailed guidelines for systematic collection of broom grass for various ranges and for the designated collection centres shall be available in the Tripura JICA project website (<http://tripurajica.com>) or can be collected from the office the undersigned.
