ORDER

**Subject:** - Proposal for diversion of 0.809 ha of forest land for establishment of BOP Nutanpara under DFO, North

User Agency (Inspector General, BSF) submitted a proposal for diversion of 0.809 ha of forest land for establishment of BOP Nutanpara under DFO, North

The State Government considered this proposal and issued In-Principle approval subject to fulfillment of certain conditions. Accordingly user agency deposited NPV & CA etc in favour of Ad-hoc CAMPA and submitted the condition wise compliance report.

Based on the compliance report submitted by the user agency vide their letter dated 17.05.2020, State Government issued Final Approval under Section 2 of the Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 vide letter No.F. 6-943/FC/For-12/7561-568 dated 04.06.2020.

In compliance of the National Green Tribunal order vide letter dated 07.11.2012 and Ministry's letter dated 24.07.2013, it was stated that **State Government to pass a reasoned order for transferring and /or allowing the land in question for being used for non-forestry purpose, hence this order is being issued.**

This final order along with the conditions imposed in the approval by the State Government is mandatorily required to be displayed in the Website. The conditions are as follows:-

- i. The legal status of the land shall remain unchanged i.e shall remain Reserved/ Protected/ Village/ Unclassed/ Other types of forests/ forest as the case may be.
- ii. The forest land so diverted shall not be used for any purpose other than specified in the proposal.
- iii. The diverted forest land shall revert back to the Forest Department when no longer needed by user agency.
- iv. Compensatory Afforestation shall be carried out over 1.62 ha of degraded forest land in CS plot No.2072, Kh.No.2/60 of Mouja-Ujan machmara under Kanchanpur Forest Sub-Division.
- v. Permanent demarcation of forest land proposed for diversion shall be done on the ground four feet high reinforced cement concrete pillars with serial numbers, forward and back bearings and distance from pillar to pillar at project cost before handing over the forest land to the User Agency.
- vi. Permanent demarcation of forest land proposed for CA land shall be done on the ground four feet high reinforced cement concrete pillars with serial numbers, forward and back bearings and distance from pillar to pillar.
- vii. The user agency to provide fuel wood preference preferably alternate fuel to the labourers and the staff working at the site so as to avoid any damage and pressure of adjacent forest areas.
- viii. The project should not involve felling of more than 50(fifty) numbers of trees/ha
- ix. The project site should be outside the National Park / Wildlife Sanctuary / Protected areas
