NOTIFICATION

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 20 of the Indian Forest Act, 1927 (Act XVI of 1927) read with the Government of India in the Late Ministry of States Notification No, 104-J, dated, the 24th August, 1950 as amended, the Administrator of Tripura has been pleased to declare the Forest land comprising an area of about 5 sq. miles situated within Kailashahar Sub-Division and described by the boundary limits as specified below, a Reserved Forest to be called "UNAKOTI EXTENSION RESERVED FOREST" with effect from 10-2-65.

- North:—Dhartuichara upto the junction of its main tributaries, then an artificial line running directly east to meet the source of Lakshmichara and Phangchara at Boundary post No. 2 of Unakoti Reserve Forest.
- East: Phangchara.
- South:— From the junction of Phangchara and Deo River moves along downstream of Deo River upto Kukichara then moves along upstream of Kukichara upto Golamjoy Reang's cultivated land, then an artificial line running towards west keeping all the existing forest plantations inside, then,
- West;— An artificial line running along the outer boundary of the existing Forest plantations, then the line crosses the Kumarghat-Kailashahar road and runs along the foot of the low lying tillas till it meets one of the tributaries of Dhartuichara, then running along the tributary meets the main Dhartuichara.

NOTIFICATION

Dated, Agartala, the 19th January, 1965.

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 20 of the Indian Forest Act, 1927 (Act XVI of 1927) read with the Government of India in the Late Ministry of States Notification No. 104-J, dated, the 24th August, 1950 as amended, the Administrator of Tripura has been pleased to declare the forest land comprising an area of about 3 sq. miles situated within Kamalpur Sub-Division and described by the boundary limits as specified below, a Reserved Forest to be called "SALEMA RESERVED FOREST" with effect from 10. 2. 65.

- East:— The line proceeds along Ambassa-Kamalpur Road excluding settled and reclaimed lands lying on the west of the said road and the western portion of Salema Bazar, Salema post Office, Relief Office, Government Dispensary Tahasil Office and agricultural farm till it meets Maharanichara. The plantation lying on the east of the said road near the Block Development Office will remain included in the Reserved Forest.
- North:—Maharanichara upto the eastern boundary of Atharamura-Kalijhori R. F. excluding settled and cultivated lands as far as praeticable.
- West: -Eastern boundary of Atharamura-Kalijori R. F. upto Daluchara, then.
- South:— Moves along downstream of Daluchara till it meets the, Ambassa-Kamalpur road excluding all settled and cultivated lands as far as practicable.
