Dated, the 24th March, 2014Subject :- Detailed procedure for extraction of trees from non-forest areas.

The Governor, Tripura is pleased to amend the para 3 of the detailed procedure for extraction of trees from non forest areas notified vide No.F.7(44) /For/FP/2001/Part-II/19630-729 dated 20th October, 2010 as mentioned below :-

The Section 3 shall be substituted by the following:-

3. Registration for Rubber Trees

3.1 Application for registration of Rubber trees shall be made to the concerned Divisional Forest Officer by the Owner along with all the documents in support of his / her claim over the rubber trees as per Form -I A.

3.2 The Divisional Forest Officer shall arrange joint verification as per Sub Section 1.4. of Section 1.

3.3 On receipt of verification report as Sub-Section 1.5 of Section 1 the D.F.O shall register the trees and issue the Tree Registration Certificate to the Owner of the tree as per Form - II A.

3.4 The owner shall inform the concerning RO and Beat officer of his intention to fell the trees in a prescribed format with a copy to the DFO as per Form- IV A & a Pass Book may maintain as per Form III A. After this the owner shall be free to fell and transport the felled logs of Rubber. He should carry the form IIIA. No.F.7(44) /For/FP/2001/Part-II/19630-729 dated 20th October, 2010 as mentioned below.

3.5 The rubber timber Processing Unit/Saw Mill etc shall open a register and maintain accordingly and submit the monthly return to the concerned DFO through the Range Officer as per format prescribed by the Ministry against the WBIEs (I (a), II (a), III (a) & III (b)).

3.6 The owner of the tree shall deposit the sale tax, income tax etc. as applicable before transportation. The buyer is also to satisfy self in respect of paying any govt. dues like tax etc.

3.7 The service charge is required to deposit by the owner @ Rs.15/- per tree irrespective of girth class before issuing issuance of TRC as per order of concerned DFO.

3.8 On receipt of verification report as Sub-Section 1.5 of Section 1 the D.F.O shall register the trees and issue the Tree Registration Certificate to the Owner of the tree as per Form - II A.

This is in modification of Notification No.F.7(186)/For-FP-1999/24,020-24069 dated 10/11/11. This is with immediate effect.

Subject:- Detailed procedure for extraction of trees from non-forest areas.

The Governor, Tripura is pleased to amend the para 3.2, 3.3 & 6 (i) of the detailed procedure for extraction of trees from non forest areas notified vide No.F.7(44)/For/ FP/ 2001/ Part-II/ 19630-729 dated 20th October, 2010 as mentioned below:-

- i. Para 3.2 - After ascertaining the status of land etc. the Range Officer shall conduct the verification/ demarcation and stand mark 300 (three hundred) trees and submit the stand marking list to the authorized officer within 15 days time on receipt of complete application.
- ii. Para 3.3- The authorized officer shall issue the permit order for extraction of 300 (three hundred) at a time, within 10 days time on receipt of marking list from the concerned Range Officer.
- iii. Para 6 (i)- Service charge for Rubber trees shall be realized from the owners of the Rubber trees @₹ 50/- per tree irrespective of girth.

This will have immediate effect.
